Session 1 Cake Decorating (\$200) - June 5-9, 2017

Times: Monday-Thursday 9:00a.m.-3:00p.m. and Friday 9:00a.m.-1:00p.m.

Includes variety of cakes, fillings, frosting, and decorating techniques. Each student will take home his/her own cake at the end of the week. Students will be provided with an apron and toolkit.

Session 2 Intro Culinary (\$200) - June 12-16, 2017

Times: Monday-Thursday 9:00a.m.-3:00p.m. and Friday 9:00a.m.-1:00p.m.

Includes knife skills, cooking methods, herbs and spices, mother sauces, meal planning, and nutrition. Students will be provided with an apron and a kitchen toolkit. Parents are invited to join their students on Friday for lunch.

Session 3 Adv Culinary (\$150) - June 19-21, 2017

Times: Monday-Wednesday 9:00a.m.-4:00p.m.

Includes advanced techniques, global cuisine, garnishing, and fabrication. Students will be provided with a chef jacket and an advanced toolkit. This session is only available to students who have previously taken the introductory culinary session.
