

2015-2016 Johnson City Schools Report Card

Due to limited state testing information from the 2015-2016 school year, the district's focus is on college and career readiness indicators.

- Science Hill's graduation rate was 91% (four years and one summer) compared to the 88.5% state average rate. This percentage showed a slight drop of .4 percent from the 2014-2015 school year; however the school's cohort dropout rate was 4% with an event dropout rate of only 1.7%.
- Science Hill's ACT composite increased to 22.8 compared to 19.9 at the state level.
- The percent of students at Science Hill who met all of the requirements for a HOPE Scholarship was 61.5 compared to 41.9 for the state.
- Science Hill students meeting all four ACT college readiness benchmarks reached 41.4% compared to the state average of 19.7%.
- Science Hill High School students outperformed the state on every End-of-Course (EOC) exam.

- TVAAS Numeracy was Level 5 indicating more growth in high school math classes when compared to the state's average growth. In fact, 56.9% of students were proficient or advanced in Algebra I, Algebra II, and Geometry compared to 20.8% for the state's average.
- TVAAS Literacy was Level 1 indicating less growth in high school English classes when compared to the state average growth; however, 46.6% of Science Hill students achieved proficient or advanced in English I, II, and III courses compared to 30.3% in the state.
